Caroline Chinakwe, a Nigerian-born mixed-media artist from North West London, crafts a captivating narrative of culture, identity, and social justice. With over 25 years in fashion, including work at Nicole Farhi and Polo Avenue, Lagos, she shifted to art in 2019, responding to the absence of diverse and positive black culture and style representations in fashion.

Caroline's evocative collages blend PopArt, Afrofuturism, and fine art, challenging norms and embracing black beauty. Notably, her "Colourism" series, born from the aftermath of the BLM protest, explores racial biases within the beauty industry and the preference for lighter skin tone within the Black and Brown communities.

Inspired by fabric buying trips to Thailand and Sri Lanka she decided she would like to explore her love of textiles and work creatively with them. Using them she considers a fresh and immediate way of storytelling. She went on to study at Morley College, Central St Martins, the V&A and more recently the Royal School of Needlework.

Imagen's most recent work focuses on portraits, mainly of women. The images have a strong narrative, often a commentary on everyday life and commonplace observation. These are images of powerful women, uplifting and playful. Worked on bright coarsely woven linens combined with vintage barkcloth, stitched unevenly with black Egyptian cotton thread giving the impression of thick inked lines. These pieces are then stretched onto large canvases which also help to contribute to their painterly quality.

Beryl Cook was a British artist known for her humorous and quirky paintings depicting everyday life and scenes of people enjoying themselves. Cook's work is characterised by bold colours, exaggerated figures, and a sense of joy and celebration, making her a beloved figure in the art world & one of Britain's best known artists.

Beryl only started painting when she was 40 years old and went on to create over 600 artworks throughout her career receiving an OBE in 1995.


Cook passed away in 2008 but her legacy of vibrant and playful artworks continues to resonate with audiences worldwide thanks to her granddaughter Sophie, who now runs the Cook estate & official website. More recently Sophie has helped put together major exhibitions in both New York and LA as well as an upcoming collaborative show with the Tom of Finland foundation at Studio Voltaire which launches in May 2024.


